



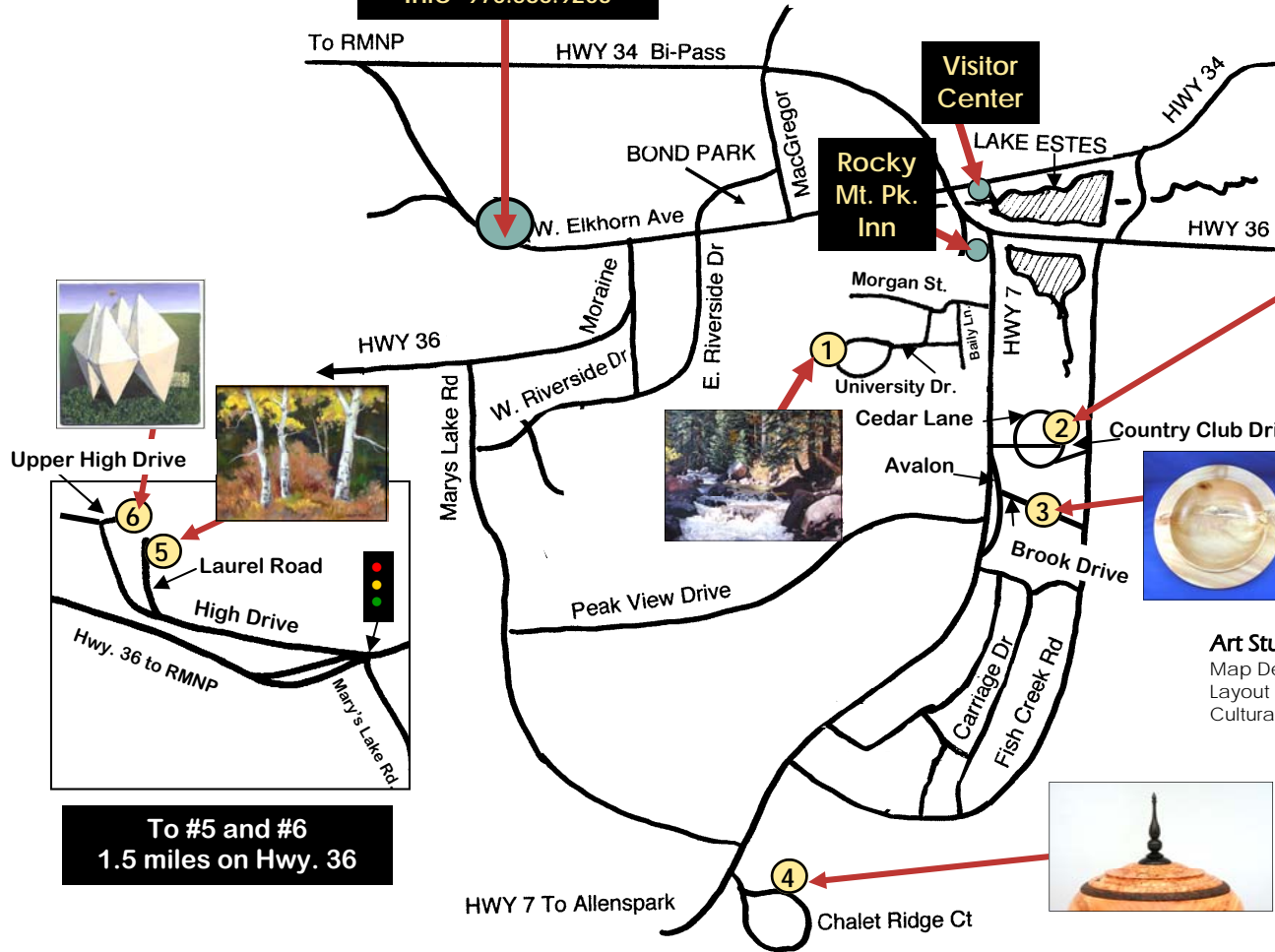

FROM THE ROCKY MOUNTAIN PARK INN
AT THE INTERSECTION OF HIGHWAYS 36
AND 7, going south of Estes Park:



1. Dennis Reinke Artist

(Oil, Watercolor, Acrylic & Sculpture)
823 University Drive

Take **Hwy 7 south .3 mile** and turn right onto **Morgan St. (.1 mile past Graves Ave.)**. Take a **second left onto University Dr.** just past **Bailey Lane**. Studio is behind our small cabin next to horse corral.



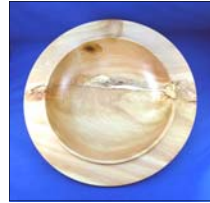
2. Greig Steiner Gallery and Design Studio

(Oil and Mixed Media)
1404 Cedar Lane

Take **Hwy 7 south** approximately **1.5 miles** and turn **left on Country Club Drive**. Proceed for **2 blocks, passing the first Cedar Lane** to the dead-end and turn **left on the second Cedar Lane**. Proceed to the **second house on the left** (1404 Cedar Lane) and to the dirt drive beyond the house. The studio entrance will be marked.

3. Roger Schuett - Unique Gifts

(Wood)
1212 Brook Drive

Take **Hwy 7 south** for approximately **1.5 miles** and turn **left onto Avalon Drive**. Proceed to **first intersection at Brook Drive**. Turn **left on Brook Dr.** and proceed to **1212** [arrow to right] and down dirt driveway with bright blue house. The studio entrance will be marked.



4. John Lynch Woodworking Studio & Design

(Wood)
180 Chalet Ridge Court

Take **Hwy 7 south** of the Rocky Mountain Park Inn for **3.5 miles**. Just past the Mary's Lake Road intersection, turn **left on Chalet Ridge Court**. Studio is on the left side across from a pond. Take the long driveway in the center that goes up the hill.

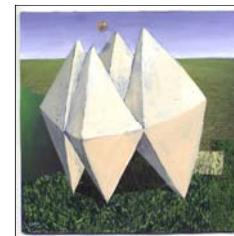

5. Wands Studio/Gallery

(Oil, Watercolor, Acrylic)
710 Laurel Road

Proceed **1/2 mile to turn right on Hwy. 36 and** continue **1.5 miles** (around the curve and towards the Park), **to the intersection at Mary's Lake Rd. (Other Side Restaurant, Sundeck Restaurant & Domino's Pizza)** Turn right on High Drive road at traffic light by the Sundeck Restaurant and Domino's Pizza. Proceed **1/2 mile to Laurel Rd.**, turn right on Laurel to second house on the right.



6. Susan Sisk, Front Range Art Services

(Oil, Watercolor, Acrylic)
1881 Upper High Drive

Proceed **1/2 mile to Turn right on Hwy. 36 and continue 1.5 miles** (around the curve and towards the Park), **to the intersection at Mary's Lake Rd. (Other Side Restaurant, Sundeck Restaurant & Domino's Pizza).**

Turn **right on High Drive road** at traffic light by the **Sundeck Restaurant and Domino's Pizza** and go **.7 miles** to **Tanager Rd.**

Turn **right on Tanager** and go **1/4 mile to the first 4-way intersection** (Upper High Drive).

Turn **right, go .1 mile; at this point the road makes a left turn** (straight ahead there is a dumpster)

Follow **the road uphill .1 mile** and go past a **"corral" on your left**; proceed straight, through a gate, into our circular driveway.

Park wherever you are not blocking the circle (parking area or side of driveway); there are stairs to the right of the concrete driveway up to the house. (Please use the stairs; the driveway can be slippery when wet). Turn right and you will see a few steps up to a somewhat concealed door. Please ring the bell solidly - it's a little ornery. Be forewarned that some mapping programs appear to have us living in the dumpster down the hill.
